

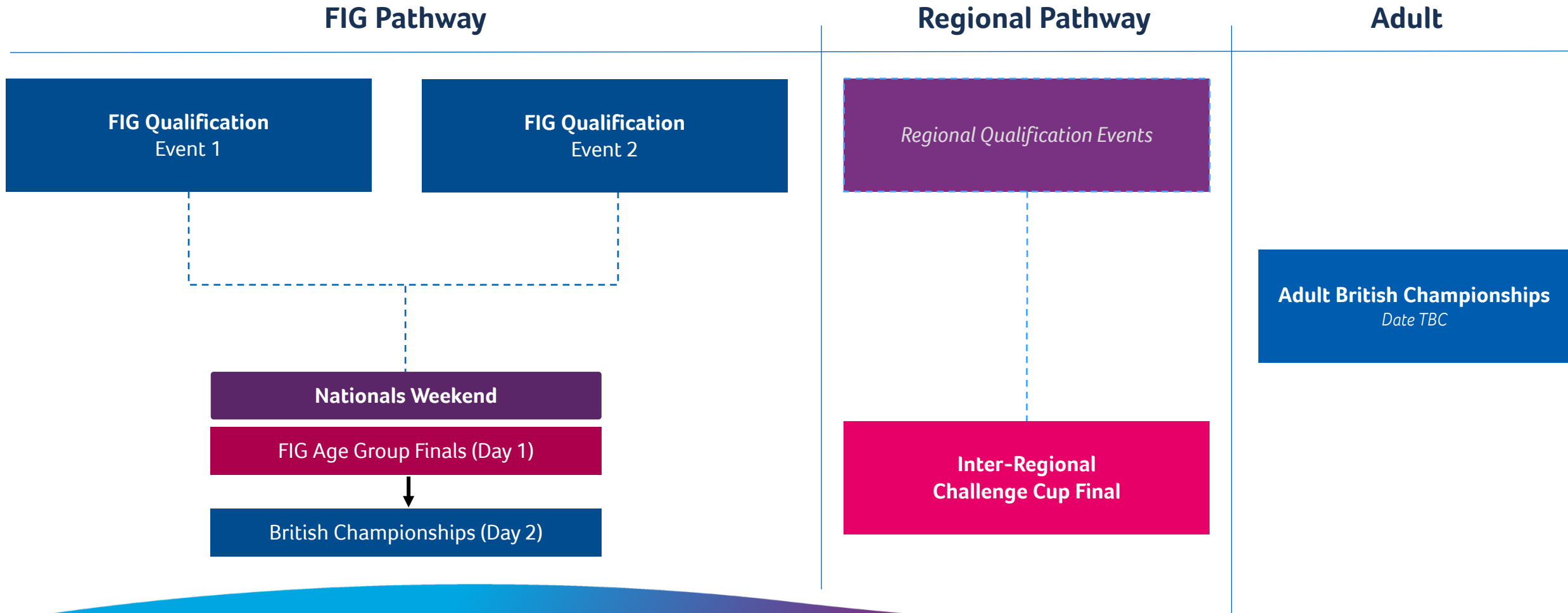

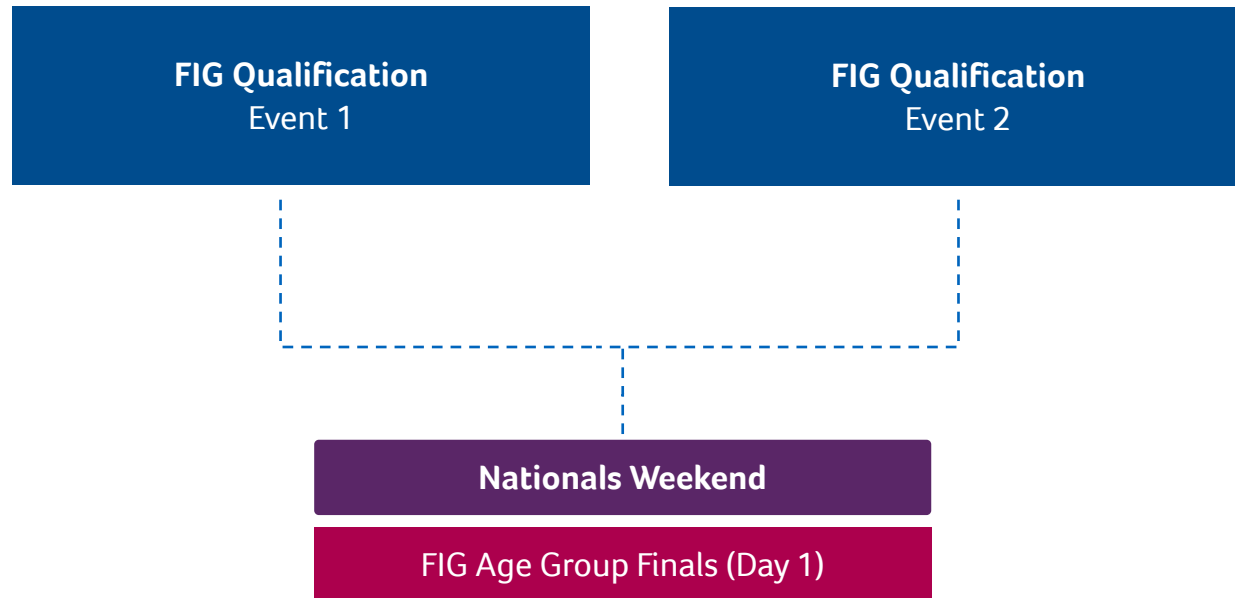

# FIG Qualification Events



## Qualification Event Format

- FIG age groups structure
- TRA & TUM: Q1 only – 2 exercises
- DMT: Q1 and Q2 – cumulative 3 exercises
- Field of Play only (no warm up hall)

## Qualification to Nationals Weekend

- Highest score across both events counted for ranking purposes
- The following proceed to the FIG Age Group Finals (Day 1):
  - TRA - Top **24** (per age group)
  - TUM/DMT – Top **14** (per age group)
  - TRS – Top **8** (combined groups)
  - DIS – Top **6** (per category)

# FIG Qualification Event Format

## Warm Ups

Warm ups and competition for all disciplines will take place on the field of play only (i.e. no separate warm up hall)

## Rounds

Q1 rounds only (2 exercises) for TRA and TUM

Q1 and Q2 rounds (cumulative 3 exercises) for DMT

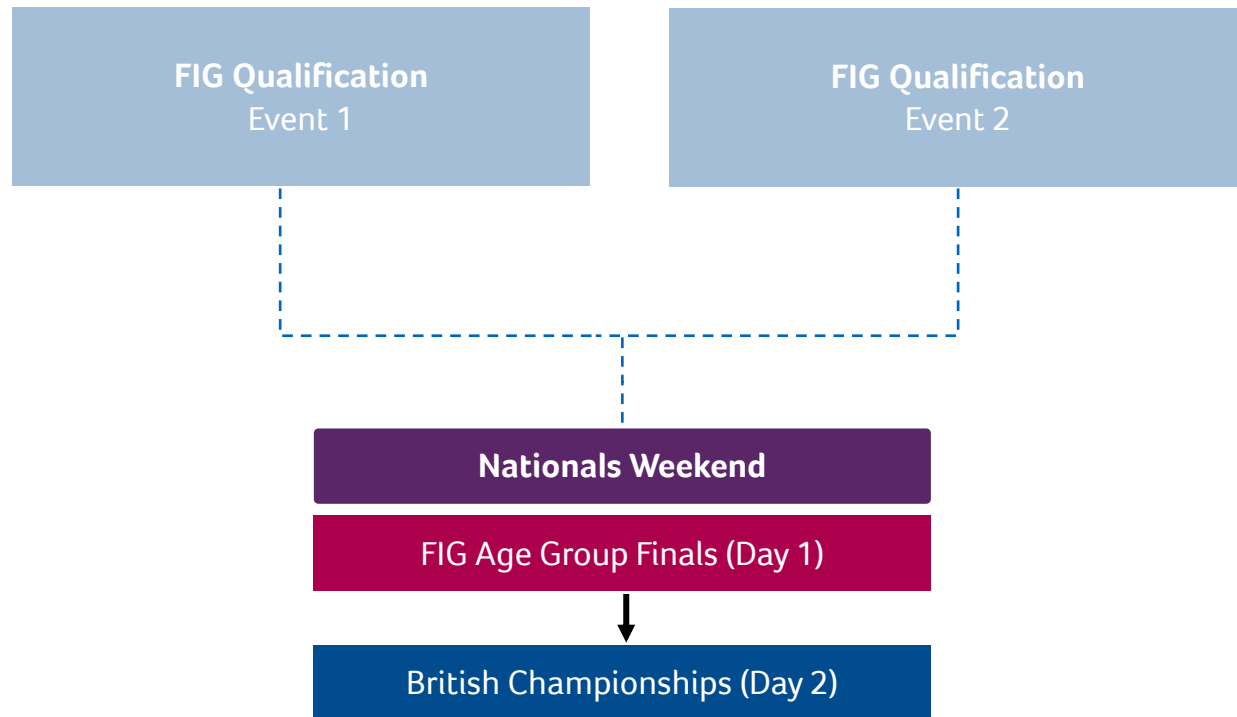

# Considerations

- **Experience**
  - Providing sufficient qualification and competition experience for gymnasts, as well as trial opportunities
  - Desire to improve event atmosphere and experience at all national levels
- **Familiarity and Consistency**
  - A subtle evolution of the 2022 and 2023 event structures
- **Financial**
  - To enable events to be viable and more accessible for gymnasts
